During Term 4, the students in Years 1 and 2 will work to complete any unfinished projects from previous terms where lessons were interrupted by Covid 19 restrictions. They will also have an opportunity to share and evaluate some of the learning that took place at home.

Students will work on a painted portrait of someone they hold close in their heart and these paintings will be used to decorate a wooden Christmas tree that will be displayed in central Geelong. They will also learn about the construction of textiles and work on projects that involve weaving yarn and decorating fabric. Stencilling and texture rubbing skills will be taught.

Students will also be introduced to digital animation and contribute to a whole class animated project. This will complement the work being done in the classroom in the Inquiry lessons.
