During Term 4, the students in Years 3 and 4 will work to complete any unfinished projects from previous terms where lessons were interrupted by Covid 19 restrictions. They will also have an opportunity to share and evaluate some of the learning that took place at home.

Students will work on a painted portrait of someone they hold close in their heart and these paintings will be used to decorate a wooden Christmas tree that will be displayed in central Geelong.

Students will also learn about the construction and decoration of textiles. They will combine stencilling, printing and texturing of paper with thickened paint and different tools. The paper they create will be woven to create a new art project. They will learn the art of tassel making and combine this skill with previous printing and painting projects. They will also explore the use of printing foam to create printed designs that could be used on paper or fabric.
