

Mathematics

In Term 4, learning in Maths will be focussed on the Number and Place Value strand of the Victorian Curriculum, building student's knowledge on Patterns and Algebra. In this unit, students will explore number patterns, solve worded problems and use equivalent number sentences to find unknown quantities. They develop strategies to strengthen their fluency, understanding, problem solving and reasoning skills.

Number and Place Value will be continued as students make connections between representations of numbers, problem solve, investigate strategies to perform calculations efficiently and identify patterns accurately.

Measurement and Geometry will be explored through Mass and Capacity and the Geometry strand of the curriculum shall include a focus on Location.

Chance and Geometric reasoning will also be explored within Statistics and Probability as students link their knowledge across different mathematical areas as well as apply it to real world situations.
