During Term 4, the students in Years 5 and 6 will work to complete any unfinished projects from previous terms where lessons were interrupted by Covid 19 restrictions. They will also have an opportunity to share and evaluate some of the learning that took place at home.

They will work on a painted portrait of someone they hold close in their heart and these paintings will be used to decorate a wooden Christmas tree that will be displayed in central Geelong.

Students will also learn about the work of graphic designers and study how the elements of art are selected and combined to create instantly recognisable logos that are used to market products. This will complement the work being done in the classroom on Enterprise in the Inquiry lessons. They will explore the use of screen printing and experiment with techniques that can be used to decorate paper or fabric. They will also study and create images that developed by cutting, folding and rearranging paper to create faces without the element of drawing or painting.
