

Music

During term 4, Year 5 and 6 students will be focussing on finalising their class performance for the CSPA musical - Aladdin. They will continue to learn to sing in parts and follow intricate choreography, along with a particular focus on stage craft.

They will study music from various cultures and listen to the ways culture has influenced music in Australia over time. Students will also explore how music exists distinctively in every culture and they will create music linked to their Integrated Inquiry unit.

Students will develop and practise technical skills and the use of expressive elements of music in singing, playing instruments, improvising, and performing music as a small group. Through sequential music learning, students perform with increasing depth and complexity.

They will continue to build on their ability to differentiate between various qualities of rhythm, pitch, dynamics and expression, as they listen to and make music both individually, in small groups and as a class.
