

# STEM

*During Term Two, the students in Years 3 and 4 will investigate and describe how people use Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics in their everyday lives.*

*Students will then investigate how the Earth's surface changes over time as a result of natural processes. They will use their investigation skills to explore different types of natural disasters.*

*Students will conduct a range of science experiments that recreate these natural disasters. They will observe and record the physical properties of materials and the changes that occur. Students will use their STEM Journals to make predictions, and record observations using diagrams and labels.*

*The theme for STEM lessons complements the Integrated Inquiry work being taught in classroom lessons.*
