

Music

During Term 2, the students in Years 5 and 6 will use their creativity to create 'Soundscapes' for a favourite book by considering the different sounds that would accentuate their story, using instruments, technology, their voices and objects in the room.

They will study music from various cultures and listen to the ways culture has influenced music in Australia over time.

Students will develop and practise technical skills and the use of expressive elements of music in singing, playing instruments, improvising, arranging and composing. Through sequential music learning, students compose and perform with increasing depth and complexity

Students will explore how music exists distinctively in every culture and they will create music linked to their Integrated Inquiry unit.

This term Year 5 and 6 students will be focussing on learning their class performance for the CSPA musical - Aladdin. They will learn to sing in parts and follow simple choreography.
